Item Description: Discussion of Website Redesign and Request to Finalize Contract with

CivicPlus for redesigning City's website

#### | BACKGROUND

For some time it has been clear to both staff and City Council members that the City's website has been overdue for a redesign. In November of 2012, the City Council authorized staff to issue an RFP to redesign the City's website in order to enhance electronic communications and civic engagement with residents. Following an extensive needs assessment, a wide-ranging RFP was issued that covered not only redesign elements, but also user experience evaluation, third-party software integration such as community engagement and service request modules, and mobile apps.

Staff recommendations were presented to the Council at the April 15, 2013 meeting. Council initially approved the website redesign recommendation, but went on to discuss reconsidering the initial approval at the following meeting on April 22, 2013. The decision to reconsider was tabled and further discussion on the matter did not take place.

#### WEBSITE REDESIGN OPTIONS

In an effort to advance improvements for the website, staff has been exploring updates with the City's current website vendor CivicPlus to improve the look and functionality of the website. In the opinion of staff, CivicPlus possesses both the ability to produce a unique, dynamic and eyecatching design. In addition, as the City's current vendor, CivicPlus would seamlessly migrate all existing content and retouch published pages to ensure proper formatting, menu structure and application of new site styles. CivicPlus has also recently introduced enhanced analytics capabilities and its new responsive design makes websites display much more robustly on mobile devices, eliminating the need for unengaging mobile sites like the one currently being used to display the City's website. The CivicPlus Content Management System (CMS) would also be enhanced by the new design as many options and aspects of its CMS are not available for integration on the current site due to its age. Lastly, contracting with CivicPlus would eliminate the need and cost of staff retraining and programming. CivicPlus' proposal to completely redesign the site is \$13,760.

#### FUTURE ENHANCEMENTS

- As the City's current vendor, CivicPlus presently incorporates third-party service providers into the City's website such as NeoGov. CivicPlus is committed to continuing to provide that service.
- Moving forward, additional items such as community engagement modules, service request

- modules, and mobile request for service apps could be incorporated into the site at any point.
- 34 Staff plans to work directly with with the Community Engagement Commission to research and
- recommend these enhancements to our website.

#### 36 POLICY OBJECTIVE

- The Council approved a Community Aspiration to improve communications with residents. An
- enhanced and easier to use website will facilitate improved communications

#### 39 **BUDGET IMPLICATIONS**

- The 2013 Communications budget included \$20,000 for a website redesign. These funds were
- not expended. We recommend reallocating a portion of these monies to the 2014 budget from the
- 42 Communications Fund reserves. Communications is an enterprise fund, for which the primary
- source of funding is cable television franchise fees. CivicPlus' proposal to completely redesign
- the site is \$13,760. In addition, the City currently budgets \$7,000 annually for CivicPlus to host
- and maintain the current website. That annual cost would be the same moving forward following
- 46 the redesign.

#### 47 STAFF RECOMMENDATION

- Approve contract with CivicPlus for redesigning the City's website. Charge Community
- Engagement Commission with exploring opportunities for enhancing electronic civic
- 50 engagement.




