Domestic Related Incident

On Wednesday, September 23, 2020, at 7:40 p.m., Roseville Police responded to Central Park, 2540 Lexington Avenue, on a female suffering a medical emergency. Officers learned the female and her children were at the park for a custody visit with her ex-husband. The woman was transported to a local hospital where medical tests determined she may have been exposed to some kind of toxic chemical.

Following continued investigation today, the ex-husband was taken into custody by the Roseville Police and is being interviewed by detectives. Out of an abundance of caution, the FBI Minneapolis Hazardous Evidence Response Team and the Minnesota National Guard's 55th Civil Support Team returned to the scene and determined there is no risk to public safety in the park.
