

- Opportunity to engage stakeholders, create goals and strategies, and develop a work plan to be successful.








## Roseville Business Council Energy Action Plan

What will we do to deliver on each strategy?






**Energy Action Plan: Vision** 


Residents and businesses in Roseville will use less energy than we have in the past, and what we do use will be cleaner. Households burdened by their energy expenses will have resources to help them.





**Energy Action Plan: Goals** 





- \$1.5 million in energy savings for residents and businesses by end of 2022.
- Roseville will reduce its carbon footprint and avoid 9,607 MTCO2e by the end of 2022— equivalent to removing over 2,000 passenger vehicles from the road for a year.














**Energy Action Plan: Business Energy Efficiency**
