The applicant understands that failure to install and maintain erosion control within the time allotted will result in the City using escrow funds to remedy deficiencies and for additional staff time. The issuance of this permit constitutes a right-of-entry for the City or its contractor to enter upon the construction site for the purpose of completing the corrective work.

I understand that this authorization constitutes and is intended to be a full and complete waiver of any notice, hearing, irregularity, appeal, or any other rights that might otherwise apply to the City's imposition of costs or assessments under this permit.
