

## 2025 Roseville Private Inflow and Infiltration (I&I) Sewer Service Grant

The City of Roseville received a **\$53,000 Metropolitan Council grant** in 2025 to help homeowners fix their **private sewer lines**. This helps keep rainwater and groundwater out of the city's sewer system.

### Who Can Apply?

- You must own a home in Roseville.
- City of Roseville employees cannot apply.
- The sewer must serve a lived-in and homesteaded home.

#### **How It Works**

- Money is given out first come, first served.
- \$20,000 is saved for people who meet equity guidelines.
- If all the money runs out, you can join a waiting list.

#### What Costs Are Covered?

- Fixing or replacing sewer pipes that are broken or have tree roots inside them.
- Video inspections and pipe cleaning if you qualify for 75% or 100% grant coverage or if repairs are needed.
- Disconnecting foundation drains and installing a new sump pump if needed.
- Permit fees (homeowner or contractor must get the permit).

## **How Much Money Can You Get?**

The grant covers part or all of the repair cost, based on need:

- 100% (up to \$10,000) if you participate in programs like SNAP, SSI, or Energy Assistance.
- 75% (up to \$7,500) if your home is worth \$290,300 or less (on Ramsey County's website).
- 50% (up to \$5,000) if you don't meet the above criteria.

## **Important Rules**

- Repairs must be done within 60 days of approval and before December 31, 2025.
- Homeowners must pay any amount not covered by the grant.
- The city pays the grant money to the applicant after the work is done and inspected.

#### **The Process**

- 1. **Send your application** to <a href="mailto:engineering@cityofroseville.com">engineering@cityofroseville.com</a>.
  - o You will get a response within **3 business days** with next steps.
- 2. **Get estimates** from at least **two contractors**.
- 3. **Send two video inspections** (your contractor will provide these):
  - One before the repair showing the problem (like cracks or roots).
  - o One after the repair showing it was fixed.
- 4. **Send a detailed invoice** from your contractor. It must include your address, what was fixed, how much was repaired, contractor's information and final cost.
