Rosebrook Playground and Splashpad Design Meetings

Dear Neighbors of Rosebrook Park:

We are excited to continue the planning process for several key updates to Rosebrook Park - most notably the replacement of the wading pool with a splashpad and updates to the playground. We invite you to join us for two upcoming meetings where we'll review preliminary design concepts, discuss options, and gather feedback to inform the final design.

**Meeting 1 – Tuesday, October 28 at 6:00pm @ The Rosebrook Park Building**

Review of multiple proposed splash pad and playground concepts that have been developed based on earlier neighborhood feedback to identify community preferences, which will be used to develop a final design.

**Meeting 2 – Wednesday, November 12 at 6:00pm @ The Rosebrook Park Building**

Open house to showcase the final design that was developed based on feedback from the previous meetings.

**Community Input to Date**

In late 2024 we began the process of discussing the replacement of the mechanically and structurally failing wading pool with a splash pad, and significant updates to the playground. At our initial meeting, we received crucial high-level feedback that informed the scope and scale of the project. Based on that feedback, additional parking near the building, pathway lighting, and repairs to the tennis courts have been added to the project.

This summer, during the *Discover Your Parks* event at the park, we gathered a significant amount of additional detailed input from residents of all ages and backgrounds. This feedback provided a foundation for the design team as they developed some unique preliminary concepts for the splashpad and playground. We are excited to share these concepts and gather feedback at the above-mentioned meetings.

**Project Timing**

Work at Rosebrook Park is currently anticipated to take place in 2026. The specific timeline will be determined based on contractor and product availability.

We hope you can join us to share your ideas and help shape the future of Rosebrook Park.
