1 **BACKGROUND**

2 Each year the League of Minnesota Cities (LMC) provides cities with Draft City Policies and
3 asks member cities to provide feedback on potential legislation that affects cities.

4 Councilmembers received an electronic copy of the Draft 2012 City Policies on October 6.

5 This information helps the League to focus their resources on topics of the most interest to
6 municipalities. Potential legislation considers ways cities can improve service delivery; improve
7 local economies; improve fiscal futures; human resources; data practices; and federal
8 employment law. The deadline to provide feedback is November 1, 2011.

9 **POLICY OBJECTIVE**

10 Ensure that the LMC works with the Legislature to protect the best interest of municipal
11 governments.
