Item Description: Community Development Department Request to Perform an Abatement

for Unresolved Violations of City Code at 648 Iona Lane

#### BACKGROUND

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• The subject property is a single-family detached home.

- The current owners are Manzoor and Mahroof Moghul who live in the property.
- Original notice was sent in June of 2008. The property owner did begin repairs (reroofing) in August, however, no maintenance work has occurred since that time and complaints continue to be received.
- Current violations include:
  - Exterior building maintenance deterioration of siding and paint (Violation of City Code Section 906.05.C).
  - Exterior storage of building materials (Violation of City Code Section 407.02.M).
- A status update, including pictures, will be provided at the public hearing.

#### 13 POLICY OBJECTIVE

- The City goals within the Comprehensive Plan are to protect and improve property values (Goal 3, 4,
- and 5; page 6 and, Section 3) and to adhere to performance standards which protect the integrity of the
- housing units and the neighborhood (Policy 6, page 8, Section 3).

#### FINANCIAL IMPACTS

# 18 City Abatement:

An abatement would encompass the following:

- Repair and repaint the entire exterior of the home.
  - o Approximately \$10,000.00 15,000.00
- Removing the outside storage.
  - o Approximately \$250.00
- 24 Total: Approximately \$10,250.00 15,250.00.

In the short term, costs of the abatement will be paid out of the HRA's budget. The property owner will

27 then be billed for actual and administrative costs. If charges are not paid, staff is to recover costs as

specified in Section 407.07B. Costs will be reported to Council following the abatement.

## STAFF RECOMMENDATION

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Staff recommends that the Council direct Community Development staff to abate the above referenced public nuisance violations at 648 Iona Lane.

## REQUESTED COUNCIL ACTION

Direct Community Development staff to abate public nuisance violations at 648 Iona Lane by hiring a general contractor to repair and repaint the exterior of the house and to remove and dispose of the outside storage. The property owner will then be billed for actual and administrative costs. If charges are not paid, staff is to recover costs as specified in Section 407.07B. Costs will be reported to Council following the abatement.
