- 34 implementation stage) and/or a statistically valid needs assessment. This
- 35 question still needs to be discussed and a thoughtful approach determined.

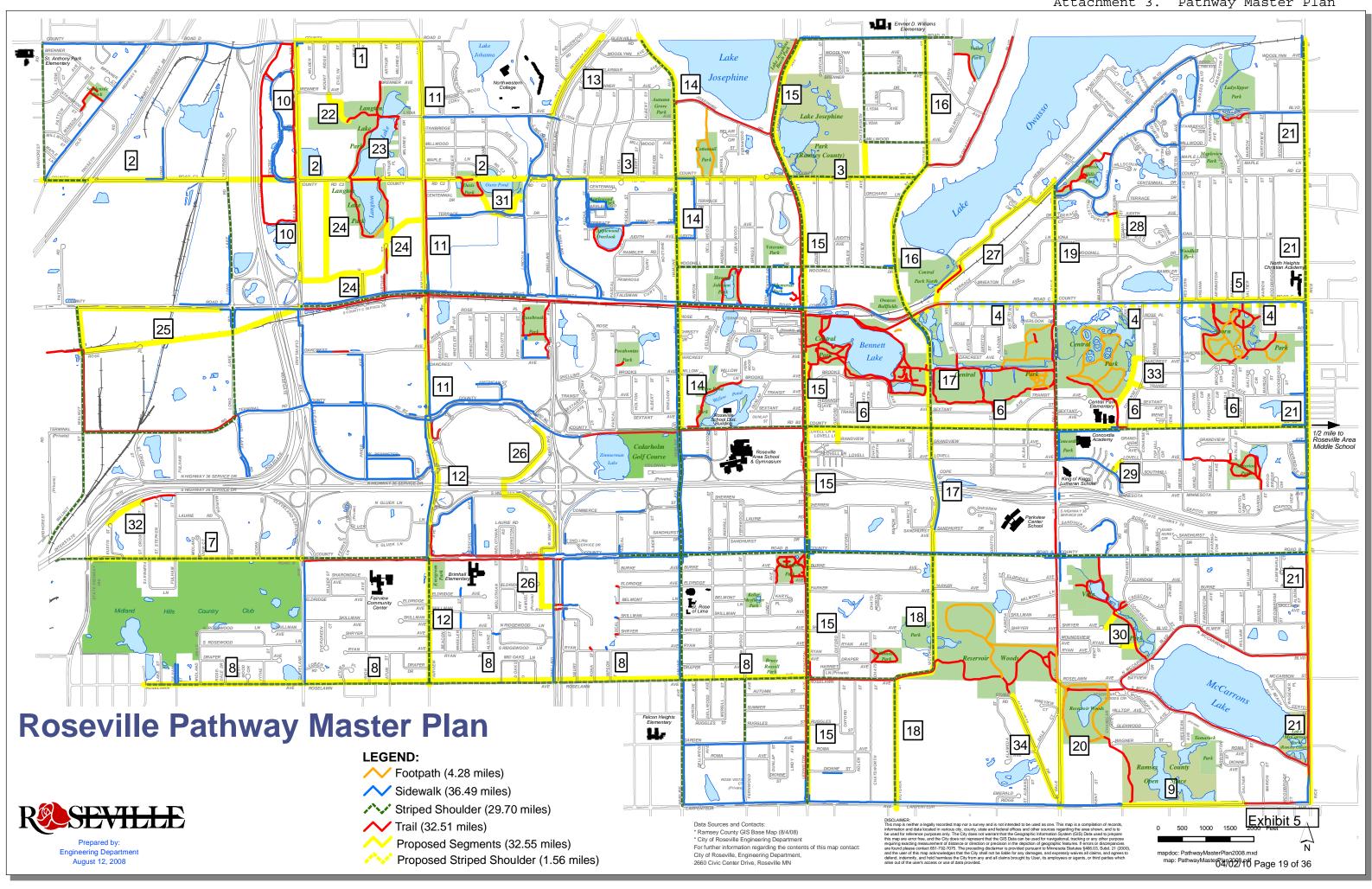

column: julia jacobson why you should care about Roseville Parks and Recreation

What comes to mind when you think of Roseville Parks and Recreation? The t-ball/soccer program, where halftime consisted of a juice box and pretzels? Climbing up and down the Rocket, the most-cherished structure of Central Park? Or skating (and falling) at one of Roseville's many public outdoor rinks? The days of these activities may have passed, but their memories live on – memories possible only through Roseville Parks and Recreation. It's the Parks and Recreation department that gives many of us a sense of our community, and here are some reasons why:

Roseville Parks and Recreation impacted many of Roseville students early in their lives.

Nearly all students in club or high school sports programs got their start in Parks & Rec. programs or associations that use Park facilities.
